The awards will be based on the results of an open book essay exam to be administered during the month of April 2018. Questions will deal with Labor Issues and Current Events.

TO BE ELIGIBLE:

- One of their parents or legal guardian <u>MUST</u> be a member of a Local Union affiliated with the VT AFL-CIO.
- They <u>MUST</u> be a graduating High School Senior or Fulltime Matriculated College Student.
- 3. They <u>MUST</u> be eligible to be claimed as a dependent on their parents or legal guardian's income tax return.
- 4. They MUST be planning to attend an accredited institution of higher education.
